

ANCIENT SETTLERS - HOSPITALITY RIDER

This hospitality rider forms part of the performance agreement between Ancient Settlers and the promoter. Its purpose is to ensure that the band can perform safely and under appropriate professional conditions.

The band travels with **five musicians**.

Ancient Settlers has **no food allergies or intolerances**. There are currently **no vegan or vegetarian members** in the touring party.

All hospitality should be available upon the band's arrival unless otherwise agreed in advance.

1. Dressing Room

Please provide one clean, lockable dressing room for Ancient Settlers.

The dressing room should include:

- Seating for at least five people
- One table
- Access to electrical sockets
- Adequate lighting
- A mirror
- Heating or air conditioning, depending on the season
- A nearby private toilet
- Five clean towels
- Bin bags or a waste bin

Access to a shower with hot water is highly appreciated, particularly after the performance.

The dressing room, stage and backstage areas must be kept secure. Only authorised personnel should have access.

2. Drinks

Please provide the following for the band:

- At least 15 small bottles of still water
- Five bottles of water available on stage
- Soft drinks, including regular and sugar-free options
- Coffee and tea
- Fruit juice
- A reasonable selection of beer
- Ice, cups and bottle openers

Alcohol should be provided in moderate quantities. Drinking water must remain available throughout load-in, soundcheck, performance and load-out.

3. Food Before the Show

Upon arrival or before soundcheck, please provide a light meal or substantial snacks for five people.

Suggested options include:

- Sandwiches or filled rolls
- Cold meats and cheese
- Bread
- Fresh fruit
- Crisps or savoury snacks
- Biscuits or cereal bars
- Yoghurts
- Coffee and tea

Please avoid providing only sweets, crisps or fast food as the sole pre-show catering.

4. Main Meal

Please provide one hot, nutritious main meal for each of the five band members.

Suitable options include:

- Chicken, beef, pork or fish
- Rice, pasta or potatoes
- Vegetables or salad
- Bread
- Dessert or fresh fruit
- Water and soft drinks

The meal should preferably be served between soundcheck and the performance. The promoter should confirm the expected meal time in advance.

There are no vegetarian, vegan or allergy-related requirements.

5. After-Show Catering

After the performance, please provide:

- Bottled water
- Soft drinks
- Beer

6. Accommodation

When accommodation is included in the agreement, please provide clean and secure accommodation for five musicians.

Preferred room configuration:

- Two twin rooms
- One single room (Female Singer)

Alternative arrangements may be accepted if agreed in advance.

Accommodation should include:

- Private bathroom facilities
- Clean bed linen and towels
- Wi-Fi
- Breakfast
- Parking for the band vehicle
- Late check-in arrangements when required

The hotel or accommodation address and booking confirmation should be sent to the band before arrival.

7. Breakfast

When the band stays overnight, breakfast should be included for all five musicians.

A standard continental or cooked breakfast is acceptable, including:

- Coffee and tea
- Juice
- Bread or pastries
- Eggs
- Cheese and cold meats
- Fruit
- Yoghurt or cereal

8. Parking and Access

Please provide a secure parking space close to the venue for the band vehicle.

The promoter must communicate in advance:

- Venue address
- Load-in entrance
- Parking instructions
- Local access restrictions
- Contact details for the person meeting the band

Parking permits, restricted-area authorisations or access codes must be arranged by the promoter where necessary.

9. Local Contact

A promoter or production representative must be available by telephone from the band's arrival until the completion of load-out. Please provide the next details.

10. Flexibility
